

RULES FOR "SCRAMBLE" TOURNAMENT

STANDARD SCRAMBLE RULES APPLY: All players hit from within one club length of the chosen shot (within 3 inches for putts). You can't improve your lie. If you are unsure of how to play a scramble, ask someone around you, someone is bound to know.

IN THE INTEREST OF SPEEDING UP PLAY, BOGEY IS THE WORST SCORE YOU CAN TAKE, SO IF EVERYONE MISSES THE PUTT FOR PAR, JUST PICK IT UP AND MOVE ON. ALL PUTTS WITHIN PUTTER LENGTH ARE GOOD, PICK IT UP AND MOVE ON.

DRIVE REQUIREMENTS: Each player's drive must be used a minimum of **two (2) times**.

Men: White Tees Women: Green Tees Seniors (65 and older): Gold Tees

MULLIGANS: Mulligans are included within the Birmingham, Liberty and Fort Pitt packages. Mulligans can be purchased separately for \$5/each Max. 2. Mulligans are to be used on an individual basis, not a team basis. In other words, if you buy the Fort Pitt package, this provides "**you**" with 4 extra shots, not the "**team**".

HAND MASHIES: Each team may use two hand mashies if you purchase any package (do not count as stroke) from a sand trap ONLY. One team mashie for each 9 holes is allowed. All four team members get one throw each from a sand trap ONLY. If you fail to get into the sand trap on the Front 9 holes, you lose that opportunity. Likewise on the Back 9 holes! ONLY 2 hand mashies allowed – one on each side. (If all team members do not buy a package, then team member who doesn't purchase a package cannot participate in toss.)

50/50 PUTTING CONTEST – AFTER HOLE 9: Sponsored by HBK.

POT-OF-GOLD – HOLE 5: If your ball stays on the green (1st shot), your name will be entered into a drawing to win half of the money collected for this contest. \$5 Hole Sponsored by Stahl Sheaffer Engineering.

Individual Advantage Packages

Birmingham Bridge Package - \$20/person

- Includes 1 mulligans, 1 Mashie (either front or back 9), 5 raffle tickets

Liberty Bridge Package - \$30/person

- Includes 2 mulligans, 2 Mashies (1 front, 1 back) 10 raffle tickets and Flagstick Assistance
- **FLAGSTICK ASSISTANCE – HOLES 6 AND 13:** Player (Not Team, just player unless everyone buys package) can lay the flagstick on the green and use as a guide to help the ball in the hole (1st putt only). You cannot “guide” or move the flagstick...Once placed, it lays on the ground and acts as a guide.

Fort Pitt Bridge Package - \$40/person (Best value)

- Includes 4 mulligans, 2 Mashies (1 front, 1 back), 1 Dinosaur, 20 raffle tickets, Flagstick Assistance and Toss your Dinosaur advantages



Toss Your Dinosaur

Each golfer is given one keepsake **dinosaur**, but the best toss is scored for the TEAM.

Like a hand mashie, the **dinosaur** toss does not count as a stroke.

It is a means of advancing the team's scramble ball at any time during a hole.

Each person in the foursome may **TOSS THEIR DINOSAURS** once per front 9 on the same shot on the same hole (decided upon by the team). The team may also **TOSS THEIR DINOSAURS** once per back 9. You will reuse the same Dinosaur you were given for all tosses.

Hint: It's best to **TOSS THE DINOSAUR** from the fringe of the green or on a very long putt because you'll probably put yourself in position for one putt. But beware! The **DINOSAUR** can bounce towards the cup, backwards or sideways!

After all the players in the foursome **TOSS THEIR DINOSAUR**, move the scramble ball marker to the location of the best toss. Do not count the toss as a stroke. Then resume play on that hole with scramble golf format.
