## **Judging Opportunities**

### **City Essay (Virtual)**

Read and review team's 1500-word essays about solutions to this year's theme!

- Time Commitment
  - 5-10 Hours December/January

### Presentation (In-Person\*)

Hear from 3 of the teams' representatives as they share with you the details of their futuristic cities as it relates to the theme. Ask your own questions or use provided prompts to learn more from the students.

- Time Commitment
  - 1 Day January or February
  - Typically weekend

### **City Model Review (In-Person\*)**

Take a direct look at teams creative and innovative tabletop models, assessing aspects of the city (e.g. infrastructure and services), including a moving part based on the rubrics provided.

- Time Commitment: about 4-8 hours on weekends
- January (regional) and/or February (national)
