- Adjacent to the College Hill Neighborhood of Easton and the Simon Silk Mill Redevelopment project







 - Benzo(a)pyrene, arsenic, lead





 - Art Displays




The South Bethlehem Greenway

- New green space in the shadow of the former Bethlehem Steel




The Bethlehem Steel

- Closed in 1998
- 4 miles of former steel land along Lehigh River
- Largest private sector brownfield redevelopment in America
- Redevelopment success story




