What is the Allegheny County Sanitary Authority (ALCOSAN)?

- City-County authority governed by the Municipal Authorities Act of Pennsylvania
- Seven member board of directors appointed by the Allegheny County executive and the mayor of the City of Pittsburgh
- Provide treatment of wastewater from 83 municipalities with discharge to the Ohio River








Regionalization

Voluntary Municipal Transfer to ALCOSAN


- Sewer lines that capture flows from more than one municipality
- Lines of 10" or greater diameter

Impacts over 200 miles of sewers and approximately 80 customer municipalities

Recommended trunk sewers for transfer to ALCOSAN






Source Control – I/I Reduction and **Green Stormwater Practices**

- Municipal source reduction studies
- Municipal flow reduction projects
- Flow monitoring
- Collaborative development of affordable flow reduction goals
- \$85 million matching fund program

- Selection Process Includes Review of Technical Proposals and Interviews
- Selections Require Approval of ALCOSAN Board of Directors
