

IWC Papers and Presentations Are Non-Commercial!

Unless specifically designated, IWC Technical Sessions are noncommercial forums. Under no circumstances should the session podium be used as a place for the promotion of a speaker's product, service, company, affiliates, or monetary self-interest.

In written presentations, the use of company name or corporate affiliation, product names, or proprietary products is permitted one time only as an initial reference, preferably early in the body of the paper, and may not be used in the title of the abstract or paper (note that the company name is allowed on the title page under the authors' affiliation/s). After the initial mention in the paper, a company, product, or process name should be referred to as "the Company," "the Product," or "the Process" for remainder of the Body and Acknowledgment sections of the Paper. The use of a corporate logo is not permitted in the paper.

For the presentation, the use of a corporate affiliation or proprietary products is permitted one time only. The company name affiliation should be on the title slide of the presentation. Following an initial, single reference in the body of the presentation, a company, product, or process name should be referred to as "the Company," "the Product," or "the Process" for remainder of the presentation. The use of a corporate logo is permitted only once in the presentation, typically on the first slide. And, if already used on the first slide, the logo is not permitted again anywhere else in the presentation, including in slide headers/footers or anywhere on the last slide.

Presentations Are Professional!

Presenters from any session podium shall refrain from overt statements or pointed humor which disparages the rightful dignity and social equity of any individual or group. Discussers shall remain professional in their review of the author's work; they must refrain from personal attacks of authors or their work.

IWC Copyright Status

As stated on the Abstract Submittal form, the IWC reserves the right of First Publication of any papers accepted for Presentation. If an author has a paper accepted for presentation, the author must not submit it elsewhere for publication without the written consent of the IWC Committee. Upon publication by IWC, the paper becomes the copyright property of IWC. By accepting the invitation to present at the IWC, the Author acknowledges his / her intent to submit *the Presentation* for publication *and obtain the required permissions and consents* for copy-righted materials used in the paper or presentation. The Engineers' Society of Western Pennsylvania, sponsoring organization of the International Water Conference, is the copyright owner of the Preprint, the final presentation and paper, and of the prepared discussion thereof.
