 - Max Grant \$4M
- Current Funding Round Open through March 31, 2024
- Lobbying for Recapitalization

Industrial Sites Reuse Program

- Assessment/Remediation of Brownfield Sites
 - \$200,000 Max Assessment
 - \$1M Max Remediation
- \$1M Grant EPA RLF Grant
 - Supplemental Request into EPA
- Lobby for Recapitalization
